The 2019 audit is not complete, Remington told the council. As of June 30, the town has \$295,197 in the PLVFD budget, she said, adding the PLVFD funds were in the General Fund, which has a balance of \$1.8 million. The PLVFD funds can be spent at any time, Remington pointed out.

Summarizing how the funds had been raised and used, Remington said that in 2017, the 10-mill allocation had generated \$303,000, and PLVFD spent \$227,000 or 91.6 percent of the revenue from the allocation. That grew PLVFD reserves by \$64,000.

PLVFD spent \$25,000 less than its budgeted amount in 2017. Remington said her figures showed PLVFD actually received more than the revenue generated by the 10-mill allo-

In 2018, Remington found a similar situation. The 10 mills generated \$326,000 and PLVFD spent \$307,000, increasing reserves by \$57,000. Once again, PLVFD spent less than its budget allowed by \$19,000.

Trustee Paul Banta said PLVFD had \$149,205 in reserves. He pointed out that PLVFD had actually received 110 percent of the 10-mill allocation in 2017 and 112 percent
