from Wells Fargo, Bob Krug from CSafe, and Max Mojab and Nate Eckloff from Piper Sadler & Co. The Council was interested in investing to make more money due to changing interest rates. There was a discussion of the risks associated with investing with banks, and securities were recommended as the most secure and liquid type of investment. Town Manager Mike Foreman is seeking direction to find the best proposal for the town.

Colorado Senate Bill 23-213

The Monument Council discussed state Senate Bill 23-213, which they claim would override the town's zoning and permit laws and transfer power to the state. All Council members stated that they believed this would be an overreach of state power
