D-38 District Accountability Advisory Committee, Nov. 12 Thoughts on a failed election effort

By Harriet Halbig The Lewis-Palmer District Accountability Advisory Committee (DAAC) discussed recent election results and future student assessment processes at its Nov. 12 meeting.

School board liaison John Magerko said that when the board made the decision to run a mill levy override (MLO) on the November ballot, the appearance of constitutional Amendment 66 on the ballot had not been finalized. He assured the committee that despite the defeat of both financial ballot issues, District 38 is still afloat and a highachieving district.

Magerko said that he felt the most positive aspect of the campaign was the number of contacts made between the district and its citizens. The board plans to determine which precincts were most in favor of the issue, and he suggested that if the board would move its meetings around in the district perhaps more members of the public would attend and be continuously informed about district ac-




