basin. Brackin submitted a resolution to the commissioners that emphasized a regional approach to stormwater.

The plan was to appoint a steering committee composed of engineers, citizens, and neighborhood organizations. It would represent and educate the community on what needs to be done to improve infrastructure to deal with flood control issues in the Fountain Creek basin, including areas such as below the Waldo Canyon burn scar.

With its regional emphasis, the revised resolution invites all Fountain Creek basin entities to participate in a "regional, sustainable approach to stormwater control" but made no financial obligation on the smaller municipalities for doing so.

After some revisions about the wording, the resolution was approved unanimously. It said the Pikes Peak Regional Stormwater Task Force requests consideration and approval of a "joint resolution on regional flood control and stormwater management between El Paso County, City of Colorado Springs, and community partners."

The meeting adjourned at 11:21 a.m.


