ment Academy waived any claim to funds generated by the 1999 MLO and will receive \$425,000 in funds and services for the first year and more than \$300,000 each year following. The district will waive the Authorizer Administration Fee, making Monument Academy the only charter school in the state with the fee waived. The contract also allows Monument Academy to choose a different chartering authority within the next two years.)

School readiness waiver

The board passed a motion to authorize a request for a waiver from TS Gold readiness assessments for kindergarteners, stating that the district's report cards are sufficiently detailed to determine readiness, and the board wants to keep student data local. Director of Curriculum Sheila Beving said that the state Board of Education will most likely vote on the


