pressed concern that marijuana is still a class 1 substance under federal law. He recommended that the board delay the vote and see what results occur elsewhere.

Foster pointed out that marijuana is in the same category with asthma and anaphylactic shock medications.

Board President Mark Pfoff suggested that the board have a second reading of the policy at the next meeting, asking Foster to develop a risk assessment if the board does not approve it at that time.

The board discussed the use of Colorado Open Records Act (CORA) requests by individuals and media. Foster said that the number of requests has increased in the past year, pointing out that the first hour spent in fulfilling a request was free of charge to the submitter, with \$35 an hour charged thereafter. He said that one individual has submitted a majority of the

Foster said that on average




